- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:18PM
- 2. Opening Prayer by Fr. Angelo
- Quorum / Roll Call—Jim Absent; Eric, Peggy, Alan, Ron attending via Zoom
- **4.** Reading and Ratification of the previous meeting minutes—Alan moved approval; Mike seconded; approved
- 5. Treasurer's Report Eric decided not to change wording on church website until WordPress comes live...Parishsoft to incorporate giving program. He had training last week with Fr. Angelo and hoping to have the giving program go live. He will take Stewardship for each month and incorporate into a financial statement. He has spoken to a few people about hiring bookkeeper, approximately \$65/hr. for about 8 hours a month. He will get QuickBooks online and suggests using TechSoup which helps nonprofits to gain access to programs at discount price...He hopes to build new chart of accounts in August. He reported that we are ok financially at this point.

Eric moved to close the GOYA account and transfer \$7512 from the GOYA account to the Operating Account to support the Communications ministry and if GOYA becomes active again in the future, we can open the account and fund up to \$2500 if needed. Helen seconded; passed.

Studio Upgrade

The addition of an interface mixer which connects our sound system directly to our livestream computer has greatly improved the overall sound quality of our video capture and stream set-up. The next step is to upgrade the video quality and as discussed previously, we are considering a 2-camera system with one camera wall mounted camera with remote control facing the Altar and a second camera mounted behind the Iconostasis facing the Altar Table. While we are exploring various cameras which balance cost and quality, a solid recommendation is the PTZOptics 30X Live Streaming Broadcast Camera. It's a reliable brand that is widely used in this specific industry which will meet our expectations sufficiently with a 30x optical zoom (a necessity considering the distance from the wall), high definition output, low-light sensitivity, and a 60.7 degree wide angle lens that can capture the entirety of the Solea.

Website

Both Spiro Kapatos and Demos Euclid are currently transitioning our website to Wordpress and are scheduled for an unveiling by the end of the month. Phase 2 (media and copy prep, site map, and infrastructure) is almost complete for the assembly phase. At this juncture, they will begin to build the visual structure and

user experience followed by A/B testing to gauge the ease of use and flag areas of opportunity.

YouTube

Our channel continues to grow steadily, gaining subscribers, views, and donations worldwide. We have reached 1319 subscribers (up 118 in the last 28 days), gaining an estimated revenue of \$150 through monetization. Additionally, in the last 28 days we have had over 12.2K views (up by over 3,000 views compared to last month) and a watch time of over 1.2K hours.

Our latest weekly (Thursday evening) venture, *Orthodoxy Questions Answered*, draws in an average of 450 views every week, prompting direct engagements with Orthodox patrons and those seeking Orthodoxy. As with YouTube advertising revenue, this program offers direct donation revenue via YouTube's SuperChat feature.

There is also the possibility of having our various parishioners' businesses advertise sponsor our YouTube channel as they do the Newsletter.
