- 4. Reading and Ratification of the previous meeting minutes-- Eric move to approve, Ron second; passed
- 5. Treasurer's Report reviewed reports—one item is stewardship fell off slightly...2.8% lower. Doubtful that we will hit \$260,000--some reasons discussed. Non restrict funds \$440,000. Quatela rental income increased with new contract. Hoping to book more events in the hall for increased revenue. We may need to offset losses of deceased members of the community-- Alan suggested that we look at those numbers

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STEWARDSHIP and FINANCIAL REPORT – FOR EOM OCT 2021

- We have roughly \$440K in unrestricted funds available as of October 31st (this includes Cash \$260K, Building \$22K, Jempelis \$71K, Festival \$67K, GOYA (\$5K excess – leaves \$2,500), Zutes Maintenance \$8K, PayPal Cash \$7K).
- January thru October 2021 compared to the same period in 2020.
- October 2021 compared to The January 1 thru October 31 period in 2021.

Observations & Notes

- 1. October financial results (see attached) include the expenses from the Golf Tournament.
- 2. October includes a \$16,908 payment to the Archdiocese which covers October, November, and December payments.
- Stewardship contributions were \$15,285 short of the \$21,660 monthly average to reach our goal of \$260,000 for the year. YTD Stewardship is \$196,356, 2.8% lower than the prior year at this point in time (2020 \$202,091). We'll need to average \$31,822 per month over the last two months to meet the goal. For reference, last year we collected \$47,030 during the last two months \$23,515 average.
- 4. The repairs & maintenance expense category has been adjusted to reflect true repairs and maintenance and not capital expenditures (new HVAC equipment, etc.). We'll follow up with the bookkeeper at the end of the year to make sure all revenue and expense items are posted properly.
- Parking lot income for October continued to grow we've increased from \$1,650 to \$2,170 in September and \$2,555 in October as Quatela expands staff to support a new spa in Victor – that number will likely drop back to \$1,650 as training requirements and staffing levels normalize. We need to insure lighting is on at the beginning and end of each day and that snow/ice is cleared timely.
- 6. Hall Rental income is trending in the right direction up 1,000% as compared to last year. We've generated \$3,860 through October over \$350 for the prior year.
- 7. October shows a loss of \$32,543 but YTD thru October is positive by \$117,427.
