## PARISH COUNCIL MEETING Feb 7, 2022

- 1. Meeting called to order at 7:46 P.M.
- 2. Opening Prayer by Fr. Angelo
- **3.** Quorum / Roll Call: Helen, Mike, Demitri on zoom, Karen Eric, Alan present; Peggy Jim and Ron absent

Fr. A introduced Sara Tone, new hall manager. She will be dealing with photos, marketing, contracts, etc. Fr. A. will send out email to parishioners about the hall rental process.

- **4.** Reading and Ratification of the previous meeting minutes: Karen moved approval, Mike seconded; passed
- 5. Treasurer's Report Eric reviewed the financial reports. He informed us that the preliminary report from 2021 showed stewardship down approximately \$5000 less than 2020. Eric stated that overall, the numbers were solid; revenue was up. He also raised the issue of inflation and the impact it should play on our candle prices which have remained stagnant for quite a number of years. He suggested that we investigate the current price of votives versus the cost of votives. He will present the data at the next meeting for a decision.
  - General Checking Account Balance: \$267,617.96
  - Maintenance Fund Account Balance: \$8,187.20
  - Capital Improvement Fund Balance: \$21,713.47

  - Snowplowing and Salting Update— Due to slip and fall incident reports from Quatella, Ed has agreed to do the salting of a portion of the rear parking lot and the front circle in addition to the walkways. Got the spreader and Ed is checking parking lot in the morning and evening.
  - Acoustical Improvements in the Hall—Eric was approached by anonymous parishioner about acoustics in the hall. The hearing aid loop needs to be updated. The parishioner

#### 9. Maintenance, Supplies Building and Property upkeep

*Church roofing update*. Andy Bouquin was responsible to coordinate getting three (3) quotes for the entire church roof to include all smaller connected rooflets. The consensus is to go with Finger Lakes based on both pricing and a review of the historical qualifications to accomplish the job. Quote Break Downs are as Follows:

- Finger Lakes = \$186,700 December 2021. Note that back in July 2019 Finger Lakes quoted \$149,700 and requoted again in August 2021 for \$156,700
- RMG Roofing = \$254,450 October 2021
- 6 Star Roofing = \$132,000 November 2021. Several inquiries were made into previous jobs with 6 -Star which indicated a less than favorable experience with roof quality and the availability of appropriate roofing materials.

Between August and December of 2021 there were multiple price increases and the cost for the Main Church Roof went up (not down)

- Installation of gas shut-off for kitchens completed
- Spring PM has been scheduled

## **STEWARDSHIP and FINANCIAL REPORT – FOR EOM DEC**

- Stewardship contributions were \$22,930 ahead of the \$21,660 monthly average to reach our goal of \$260,000 for the year. YTD Stewardship is \$219,286, 2.5% higher than the same period in 2020. We'll need \$41K in December to reach our goal.
- 2. As reported earlier, there are a couple of financial entries that need further clarification and reposting. We'll follow up with the bookkeeper when the YE data is available to make sure all revenue and expense items are posted properly.
- 3. The year over year comparison report (Jan 1 thru Nov 30 2021 as compared to the same period in 2020 shows some positive revenue trends concluding;
- 4. Candles, Sunday & Other both up over 95% and up \$26K over the prior period.
- 5. Donations Unrestricted up \$76K or 142% over the prior period.
- 6. Memorial Donations up \$48K or 85% over the prior period.
- 7. Parking Revenue up \$21K or 172% over the prior period.
- 8. Hall Rental Income up \$4K or 1,178% over the prior period.
- 9. Flower Receipts up \$6K or 368% over the prior period.
- 10. Expenses increased during the period but over all our Net Income was \$146K up 54% over the prior period.
