STEWARDSHIP and FINANCIAL REPORT – FOR EOM JAN 20223

1. Financial Report January 2023 – We had roughly \$466K in unrestricted funds available as of January 31, 2023. This includes Operating cash \$48K, Building \$22K, Jempelis \$71K, Festival \$291K, GOYA (\$5K excess – leaves \$2.5K), Utes Maintenance \$28K, and PayPal \$1K. Note, this compares to \$445K in unrestricted funds as of this time last year.

General comments follow;

- 1. Stewardship for January was \$28,082 61.2% or \$10,657 ahead of the same period in 2022. For reference, our \$260K annual target averages \$21,670/month.
- 2. Memorial Donations for January 2023 were \$2,950 versus \$870 in January 2022.
- 3. Total Revenue for January 2023 was \$39,127, a \$12,779 increase over January 2022.
- 4. Staff Salaries are up over January 2022 as we've expanded Demos' roll to include Youth Director.
- 5. Church Expense of \$10,075 covered the cost of the new chairs for the hall.
- 6. Repairs & Maintenance expense was \$8,910 in 2023 compared to \$1,913 in 2022. This year's total included \$3,713 to EMS for live stream cameras and TV's and \$2,149 to Crosby Brownlie for maintenance.
- 7. Financial Report January 2023 roughly \$466K in unrestricted funds available as of January 31, 2023. This includes Operating cash \$48K, Building \$22K, Jempelis \$71K, Festival \$291K, GOYA (\$5K excess leaves \$2.5K), Utes Maintenance \$28K, and PayPal \$1K.
