- Reading and Ratification of the previous meeting minutes—Van moved approval;
 Peggy seconded; passed.
- 1. **Treasurer's Report** Eric reported that we had roughly \$466K in unrestricted funds available as of January 31, 2023. The total unrestricted funds as of February 28, 2023 is \$493K. This includes Operating Cash \$213K, Zutes Maintenance \$28K, and PayPal \$2K. He reviewed the financial summary below and noted that stewardship was way up in Feb.

Youth Director	Participated in Archdiocese Youth Ministers conference from 31Mar-3 Apr. This newly formed Orthodox Young Adult Ministries (OYAM) was held at St George Antiochian Church in Houston TX. Seeing the Youth Facilities at the Orthodox Churches in the Houston area, their hours or operation, and the attendance of these facilities indicates that this is a valuable part of successful youth ministry. See attached plan for the Youth Facility here at Annunciation. While this was a 5th year goal in my Youth Strategy guide interest in creating a viable youth facility, volunteers, and donors who are willing to help would support moving this effort forward.	Monthly Youth Ministry "Good News" Will establish with each ministry an online newsletter which should go live next month. Key to this project is a main article which will be penned by a rotating selection of key representatives from each group (including myself) to make sure we all collaboratively have a voice to the youth and community. I will be penning the first article which will introduce the concept and goals for these programs. LOCK-IN Rock Climbing and Lock-In. The event will be held between 7pm May 12th (Fri) to 8am May 13th (Sat). The event will include: • rock climbing • overnight lock-in at the rock-climbing venue which will host games and challenges • catered late night supper/snacks • "struggle" theme with talks from the participating priests and youth leaders • breakfast at the church at 8:30am Additionally, we are providing FREE rock-climbing training for all volunteers. I will reach out to ENA to see who is willing to participate so we can propagate a culture of young adult role models for our youth. I will be sending out fliers, event info, volunteer pitches, waivers, and more in the next week.

STEWARDSHIP and FINANCIAL REPORT – FOR EOM FEB 2023

- 1. Financial Report February 2023 includes a Balance Sheet at the end of the report. We had roughly \$466K in unrestricted funds available as of January 31, 2023. The total unrestricted funds as of February 28, 2023 is \$493K. This includes Operating Cash \$213K, Zutes Maintenance \$28K, and PayPal \$2K.
- 2. Please note, as discussed in our last meeting we consolidated funds into the Operating Cash account and closed the following checking accounts; Building, Jempelis, Festival, and GOYA. This allowed us to place \$250K from Operating Cash into a 6-month CD earning roughly 4.25%. We anticipate roughly \$10,600 in interest income from this investment.
- 3. January thru February 2023 compared to the same period in 2022.
- 4. February 2023 compared to January thru February 2023.

General comments

- 1. Stewardship for February was \$49,675 a record month! The first two months of 2023 are 52% or \$26,442 over the same period in 2022. For reference, our \$260K annual target averages \$21,670/month we're 79% ahead of this goal as of February 28th.
- 2. Memorial Donations through February 2023 were \$6,060 versus \$3,630 through the same period last year.
- 3. Parking and Hall Rental income was \$8,355 through February 2023 versus \$5,823 through the same period last year a 43% increase.
- 4. Staff Salaries are up as we've expanded Demos' roll to include Youth Director.
- 5. Church Expense of \$10,075 covered the cost of the new chairs for the Hall. Note that this was subsidized by several of the church ministries.
 - a) \$2000 Agia Paraskevi Society
 - b) \$2000 Seniors Group
 - c) \$3000 Hellenic Cultural Society
 - d) \$3000 Philoptochos
- 6. Repairs & Maintenance expense was \$8,910 in 2023 compared to \$1,913 in 2022. This year's total includes
 - a) \$3,713 EMS services
 - 1. Installation of security live stream cameras that allow us to monitor the premises 24/7 with recorded video.
 - 2. TVs for the Sunday School classrooms as teachers migrate to on-line lesson plans, Virtual Sunday School videos, and Archdiocese video programs for Greek School.
 - **b)** \$2,149 to Crosby Brownlie for maintenance.
