PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES January 8, 2024

- 1. Meeting called to order at 6:08 p.m.
- 2. Opening Prayer by Fr. Angelo
- 3. Quorum / Roll Call—Patty absent; Zac Graham (newly elected PC) present
- 4. Reading and Ratification of the previous meeting minutes

Karen moved approval of Nov minutes; Ron seconded; passed.

Demitri moved approval of Dec. minutes; Eric seconded; passed.

5. Treasurer's Report – Eric reviewed report and commented that stewardship for year close to \$282,000--over budgeted amount.

We had roughly \$557K in unrestricted funds available as of November 30, 2023. This includes Operating Cash \$131K, Zutes Maintenance \$28K, PayPal \$3K, and \$395K in four CD's. Please note, as discussed in our Spring 2023 meeting, we consolidated funds into the Operating Cash account and closed the following checking accounts; Building, Jempelis, Festival, and GOYA. This allowed us to place \$250K from Operating Cash into a 6-month CD earning roughly 4.25% at that time.

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STEWARDSHIP and FINANCIAL REPORT – FOR EOM NOV

General comments

- Stewardship through November is up \$17,987 or 8.2% over the same period in 2022. For reference, our \$260K annual target averages \$21,670/month. Stewardship for October 2023 totaled \$13,106.
- Stewardship contributions for December 2023 were roughly \$43K allowing us to finish 2023 at \$282K a 10% increase over 2022.
- Memorial Donations through November 2023 were \$22,048 versus \$31,738 through the same period last year a difference of (\$9,689) or (30.5%).
- Candle receipts through November 2023 were up 0.5% or \$236over the same period last year.
- Hall rental through November 2023 was up \$3,781 or 36% over the same period last year.
- Parking income through November 2023 was up \$7,499 or 32% over the same period last year.
- Utility expenses are within \$4.00 of the total spent through the same period in 2022.
